

## 1. Hajj

- Why do pilgrims stand during “the standing” and where does it take place?
- After sunset on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the Hajj what do pilgrims gather?
- What do pilgrims sacrifice at the end of their third day of Hajj?
- What do pilgrims remove as a symbol of their humility?
- What do pilgrims do during the tawaf?
- How many days do Pilgrims usually stay at Mina?

## 2. Passover Seder

- Before the first night of Passover, the home is cleared of hametz. What are hametz and why are they gotten rid of (what do they symbolize)?
- List the 5 symbolic foods on the Seder plate and tell what each one stands for/ symbolizes.
- What is the meaning of the fifth cup of wine poured and placed on the Seder table?
- Who answers the 4 questions traditional at the Seder?

## 3. Ramadan

- Traditionally, what happened in Muslim history during the month of Ramadan that makes it so special?
- The third “pillar” or basic duty of Islam is observed in this month – what is it?
- What happens at sunset during Ramadan?
- What do many Muslims do during the “Night of Power”?
- What is the Eid-ul-Fitr?

## 4. Mikvah

- What is a Mikvah?
- Where does the water contained within a Mikvah pool come from?
- What did Mikvahs have to do with the temple in ancient times?
- Modern Orthodox Jews only require Mikvah’s at specific times or occasions – what are those times/occasions?
- What Christian tradition/ sacrament comes from this tradition?

## 5. Communion/ Eucharist

- What Bible event does Christian communion or Eucharist celebrate?
- What feast were Jesus and his disciples observing at the first “communion”?
- What two foods are commonly shared during communion?
- Who is supposed to participate in communion?
- What is transubstantiation?
- Do all Christians view or celebrate communion the same way?
